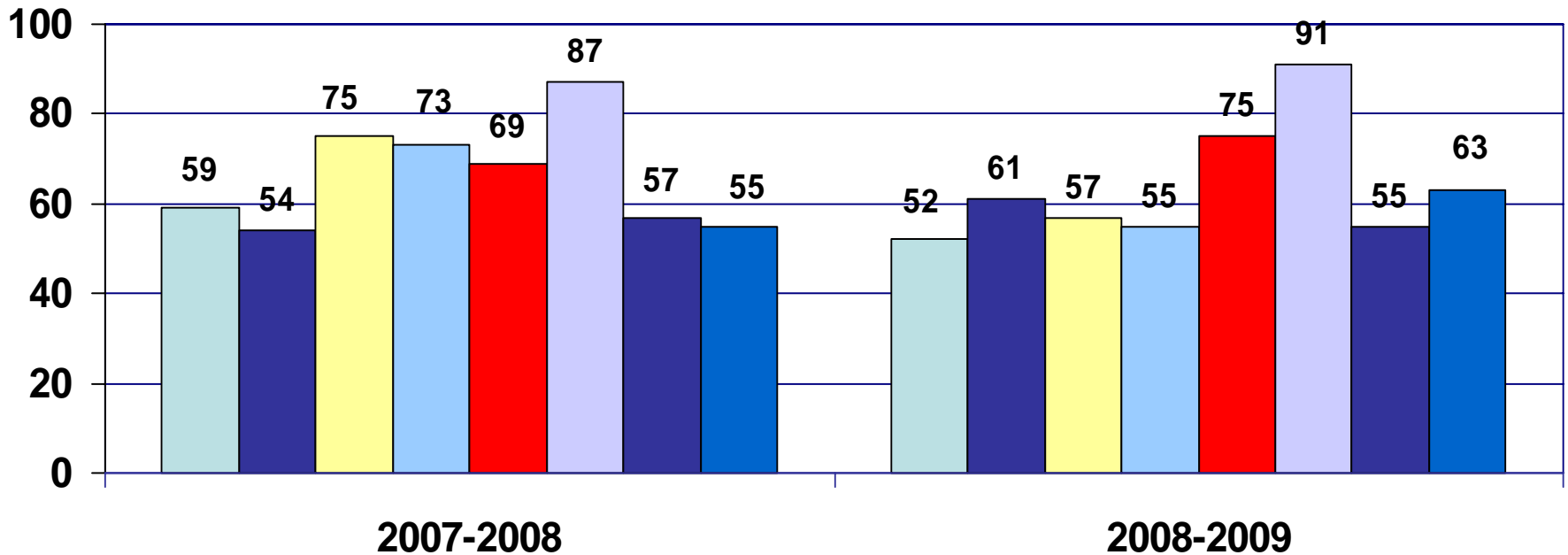

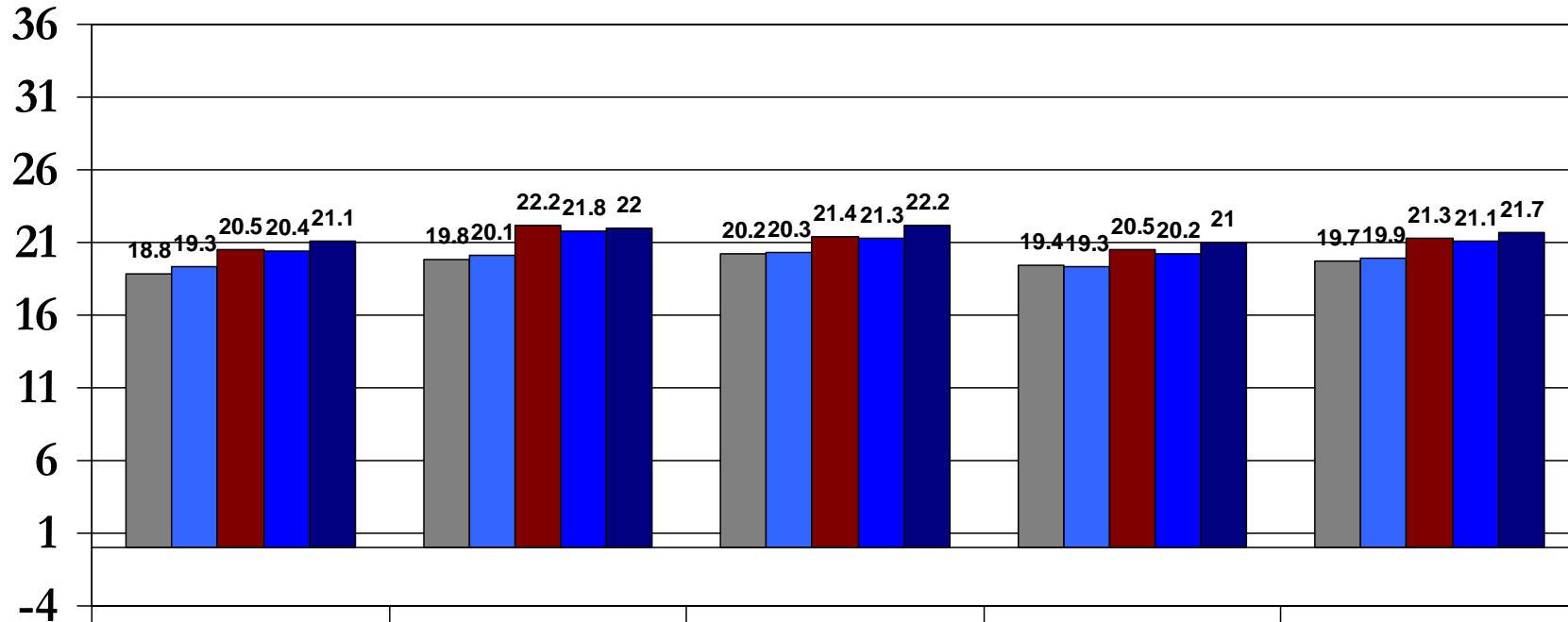
- Utilize Connect-Ed telephonic messaging service to inform parents of daily absences
