**Additional Highlights -based on average CRCT scores across the State of Georgia**

**West Side-**

1st graders scored in the top 2%, 3% and 7% for the state in Reading, Math and Eng/Lang. Arts (top 3% and 4% in Exceeds category).

2nd graders scored in the top 30% in the state across all subjects and 3rd grade moved into the top 35%.

**A.L. Burruss-**

1st graders were well in the top 12% across the state in all three subjects (top 15% in Exceeds category).

2nd graders scored in the top 31% in the state across all subjects and 3rd grade moved into the top 25%.

**Hickory Hills-**

5th grade Math had a strong performance, ranking in the top 28% and 100% of students met and exceeded standards.

**MCAA-**

3rd, 4th and 5th graders scored in the top 5% throughout all subjects with more than half the students exceeding standards.

**Dunleith-**

2nd grade Math ranked in the top 26% for the State.
